CHAPTER 18

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MAIN AND SECONDARY BUILDINGS

18.1 GENERAL STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO THE MAIN BUILDING

The construction standards of the main building are specified by district as in table No 5 of this bylaw. They include:

- > Minimum lot line:
- ➤ Minimum back yard lot line: corresponding to either a percentage of the average depth of the lot, parcel or site, or to a pre-determined distance in meters in relation to the back line of the lot;
- ➤ Minimum side yard lot line; in regards to a semi-detached building, one of the lines is void and the other line must respect the pre-determined norms. In regards to the row house, the units adjacent to each other have side yards lot lines which are void and the units located at the extremities must respect the appropriate layouts to the determined side yard lot lines per district, never being below 3 meters;
- ➤ Minimum front yard width: minimum width at the front of the main building without adjacent accessory buildings;
- ➤ Minimum surface to the ground : ground surface to the main building;
- ➤ Maximum percentage of occupation of the ground : area on the ground of the building in relation to the total surface of the ground;
- > A maximum number of levels : excludes basements lower than 1.2 meters below ground.

18.2 GENERAL STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO THE SECONDARY BUILDING

The standards of construction of secondary building are specified by district as in table No 5 of this bylaw and in this article. They include:

a) Adjacent secondary buildings (adjacent secondary building to the main building)

Applicable Standards by district (see table No 5):

- > Minimum front yard lot line
- ➤ Minimum back yard lot line
- ➤ Minimum side yard lot line

Standards applicable to all districts:

- > The maximum width of the adjacent secondary building must not exceed the width of the main building;
- ➤ The maximum covered lot surface of the adjacent secondary building must not exceed the rough surface of the main building;
- > The maximum height of an adjacent secondary building must not exceed the height of the main building.

b) <u>Detached secondary buildings</u> (detached secondary building of the principal building)

Applicable Standards by zone (see table No 5):

- ➤ Minimum back and side yard recession lines;
- > A maximal number of buildings : including all the detached secondary buildings;
- ➤ Maximum total surface: cumulative for all the detached secondary buildings in square meter. At no time, the maximum surface of the detached secondary building must exceed 10 % of the total surface of the lot nor exceed the surface of the main building. However, the surface of the detached secondary building will be able to exceed 10 % of the total surface of the lot if it is established on a secondary site;
- ➤ Maximum height of the walls : taken between the level of the floor and the highest point of a wall (the maximum height does not apply to communication infrastructures such as microwave towers);
- ➤ Maximum height: taken between the level of the ground and the highest point of construction (the maximum height does not apply to communication infrastructures such as microwave towers).

Applicable Standards to all District:

- ➤ Minimum space to leave vacant between a secondary building and a main building is set at 2 meters;
- ➤ Minimum space to leave vacant between two (2) secondary buildings is set at 2.0 meters;
- ➤ When a detached secondary building is planned to be on the same site as the main building and the minimum back or side yard recession line is measured starting from the alley, this back or side yard recession line will be 1 meters despite Table No. 5.
