RESIDUAL WASTE MANAGEMENT

POLICY DURING PUBLIC EVENTS

Before the event

- Determine the type of residual waste that will be generated during the event (recyclable, compostable or waste materials);
- Ensure the bins are identified and in sufficient numbers for each category of materials;
- Inform volunteers and support staff working at the event about managing residual waste.

During the event

- Name a person who will be in charge of managing the residual waste and sorting the materials properly;
- Sort the different materials immediately and put them in the proper bins.

After the event

- Dispose of the different materials according to the type of treatment required.
 - Recyclable material: Transfer area at the Reclamation Centre;
 - Compostable material: Composting deck at the Reclamation Centre;
 - Household waste: Transfer area at the Reclamation Centre.
